is a Professor of Child Psychiatry and Child Health as well as Chief of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at the University of Missouri-Columbia. As the founder of the International Psychosocial Trauma Center at MU, Husain and his trauma teams have made numerous trips to war-torn regions, including Bosnia-Herzegovina, Pakistan, Chechnya, Palestine, and Jordan, to train teachers and mental health professionals to help children deal with the trauma and tragedy associated with war. Dr. Husain also worked in the regions of South and Southeast Asia devastated by the massive tsunami in December 2004.
